In 1990 Rick became President of Helios and took over as President of the Harbinger Company that same year. Harbinger, a leading manufacturer of distinctive commercial carpeting, and Helios had combined sales of \$67 million in 1992. Rick remained President of both companies until Mohawk purchased Horizon Industries in October of 1992.
